



Digital Learning Expectations for DMS Virtual Students

- **All digital courses will be in Canvas.** All teachers will create a homepage where assignments will be posted. Check your homepage for your class assignments, links to learning, and other important information from your teachers.
- **Grades will count.** Assignments will be given by your teachers and are expected to be completed and submitted on time. All assignments will have due dates. Points may be deducted for assignments that are not submitted on time. **Please refer to your teacher's home pages for detailed information about expectations for each class.**
- **Students must log into and participate in each course daily.** Completion of digital assignments is required for all classes. Students will be provided with a link on each teacher's Canvas homepage to participate in daily instructional activities. If a student is unable to attend the live sessions offered this must be communicated in advance to teachers. Completion of assignments will factor into grades.
- **Attendance process and expectations:** Attendance in daily instructional activities is a critical aspect of digital learning. Students are expected to let the teacher know in advance whenever they are not able to attend a live instructional session.
- **Students should communicate with their teachers using Canvas. Students should check inbox and notifications daily. This will be a key method for students to stay connected with teachers during virtual learning and to receive feedback.**
- **It can be easy to get behind as a digital student.** Manage your time wisely. Plan ahead and don't wait until the last minute to get your work done.
- **Always do your best.** Teachers need you to do your work and put forth your best effort so they can monitor your learning, give you feedback and adjust their instruction based on your needs.
- **REMEMBER** – if you have signed up to be a virtual student, this is a 6 week commitment. The first date you would be able to return to school in person would be Tuesday, Oct. 13.
